This funding will be used to

- Guarantee that 75% of Prep students will be able to compose and record short, meaningful sentences by the end of 2019.
- Maintain the percentage of students in Year 3 and Year 5 at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard so that both year levels are statistically similar to or above the Nation in Writing.
- Maintain Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN Mean Scale Scores in Writing so that they are statistically similar to that of the Nation.

Our initiatives include

- Analysing student performance data to identify, target and track student improvement in Writing to develop Individual Student Learning Goals for Writing.
- Explicitly teaching Writing using Pearson's Gradual Release of Responsibility Model.
- Provision of planning days to support implementation of English pre and post-moderation.
- Increasing the opportunities for staff and students to access information technologies to support teaching and learning.
